Burns Injury

INTRODUCTION

Your child has sustained a burn. Superficial burns to the limbs or body will be dressed with Jelonet Dressing and layers of other dressing. Please keep these dry and clean.

If necessary give your child pain relief such as Calpol or Ibuprofen. Please ensure you read and follow the dosage instructions on the bottle or packet carefully.

Burns to hands and feet may initially be treated with antiseptic Flamazine cream and covered with a plastic bag. This is usually removed in Accident and Emergency after 24 hours. The skin will look discoloured and soggy when the dressing is removed, but will return to normal when the skin dries out.

The burn dressing should remain undisturbed until your child's appointment at the Burns Clinic in the Paediatric Accident and Emergency Department unless:-

- Fluid seeps through the dressing
- It becomes accidentally wet
- Your child experiences increasing discomfort after initial improvement.
- Your child feels ill and/or develops a temperature.

Should any of the above take place, take your child back to the Paediatric Accident and Emergency Department.
