The Children's Out-patient Department can be found on the 3rd floor, Out-patient's Entrance, St Peter's Hospital.

Your child's diabetes management will be formally reviewed by the team every 3-4 months. Please feel free to raise any relevant concerns at this time.

Remember to bring the blood sugar diary.

Occasionally, as a learning experience, other doctors and nurses attend the clinic.

We will aim to inform you if this is the case.

Home Visits

The diabetes nurse may visit you at home to give advice and support. She can also visit your child's school, club etc., in order to give specialist advice to your child's carers.

Parents' Support Group

Meetings are held every 3 months, on Oak Ward, St Peter's Hospital on a Saturday afternoon. Occasional evening meetings are organised with outside speakers.
